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1. Introduction

Litex Promo offers a durable, high-quality advanced product in the form of a sunshade. The characteristic feature of the parasol is its functionality and modern design, providing a sense of comfort. The parasol is a perfect addition to any outdoor area of a restaurant or hotel.

The user manual applies to the sunshade and considers the following:

- Safety,
- Installation,
- Exploitation,
- Maintenance.

The parasol has been designed to act as a shield from the sun and is therefore intended exclusively for such use. It is absolutely necessary to use it only:

- As intended, i.e. as a sunshade,
- Under correct technical conditions.
- Under correct weather conditions.

Irregularities which may affect the safety and functioning of the sunshade must be rectified immediately, otherwise its further use is prohibited.

All basic maintenance operations described in the manual can be carried out by the user. Any other complicated repair operations should not be carried out by persons not competent to safely operate the tools used for repair.



2. Information

2.1. Important symbols

The graphic symbols in the operating instructions specify the following safety information:



Labeling for parasol – nameplate.



Attention

This symbol indicates information that relates to the danger of injury or accident. The parasol should be transported and installed by at least two people.




Disclaimer

This symbol indicates general instructions for use of the product. In high winds (example 7.9 m/s (28 km/h) - this depends on the model of parasol) the parasol should be folded and protected against damage. Staying under the parasol in winds above the indicated permissible speed can be hazardous to your health or life.




This symbol indicates general operating instructions for the product. The base of the parasol must be levelled.



This symbol indicates general operating instructions for the product. The parasol base must be placed on a firm surface. The parasol must be mounted to the cap of the parasol base using the supplied screw.



This symbol indicates general instructions for use of the product. The parasol base must be dedicated to the type of parasol as declared by the manufacturer (example > 160 kg means that the base must weigh more than 160 kg - the weight of the base depends on the model of parasol).



This symbol indicates general instructions for use of the product. When folded, the parasol must be fastened with a safety band to prevent it from opening by itself.

2.2. Safety information

Attention: Safety hazard

- Place the parasol only on a stable surface and in the original bases designed for it.
- Always ensure that the mast is firmly attached to the base of the parasol.
- Always close the sunshade and put the cover on when moderate winds increase or rain or snow comes.
- Do not hang any objects (e.g. clothes) on the ribs of the parasol.
- The parasol is not suitable for use under snow load. In this case the parasol must absolutely be closed and fastened with a band to prevent it from opening by itself.

Description of moderate wind strength:

Winds of approximately 7.9 m/s (28 km/h):

- Effects on land: dust and paper rise, branches start to move.
- Effects on water: small waves on whose crests foam forms, splashing can be heard.

In the event of wind exceeding the above permitted speed, the parasol should be removed from the socket, placed in a horizontal position and secured. For bases with a hinged cap, lay the parasol with the cap in a horizontal position and secure.

Marning: Risk of accident

- Before opening the sunshade, make sure there are no people around and before closing it, make sure there are no people under the sunshade.
- A sun parasol is not a toy.
- The product must not be operated by children or persons requiring care.
- Make sure that children do not use the sunshade as a play area or climbing object.

∧ Caution: Risk of fire

No open fires, e.g. garden barbecues or barbecues, are allowed under or near the parasol. Fabric is a flammable material, so the cover should be kept at a safe distance from heat sources.

⚠ Note: Risk of damage to health

Repair work on the parasol must only be carried out by a person competent to use the required tools.

▲ Warning: Risk of an accident!


It is easier to install a parasol with the second adult's help. Do not use sharp tools to unpack the product. Do not place directly on the floor / ground – we recommend using a protective underlay, e.g. cardboard / foil / blanket to avoid scratching / soiling the product. Before installing make sure that core parasol base is safely mounted and stable. Due to the weight of the base, it should be transported by min. two adults. Once the base is in position, insert the parasol into the base cap and secure by inserting and tightening the locking bolt provided. Tighten the bolt to the maximum resistance. During operation, the user must check / control the tightening of the screws of both the base and the parasol cap.


When opening / closing and moving, do not put your hands / fingers between the moving parts of the frame structure. Do not insert fingers or any objects into the holes in the parasol pole. When opening / closing, do not place your hands on the mast pipe.

The parasol and base should be inspected at least once a year. Particular attention should be paid to the connections between the structural elements of the parasol, possible corrosion of materials and their strength.




































6.1 Mounting a parasol with a ground-mounted base





































6.2 Assembly of parasol with rotator and cap (as an option)




































6.3 Rotating the parasol with the rotator









7. Exploitation of the parasol


7.1. Opening the parasol

▲ Warning: Risk of an accident!

Before opening the parasol make sure that there are no people or objects near it.

To unfold the parasol canopy:

- 1. Remove the caps securing the holes on the back of the parasol leg.
- 2. Unfasten the safety strap.
- 3. Press the release on the handle (Fig. 3a) and, without releasing it, push the canopy with the other hand (Fig. 3b).
- 4. Move the handle along the leg until the desired degree of inclination is achieved, while turning the crank to open the canopy. NOTE: To avoid damaging the opening mechanism, keep the canopy under moderate tension.
- 5. Release the locking mechanism at the desired point on the leg.
- 6. Secure all openings located on the rear of the leg with caps.



7.2. Closing the parasol


▲ Attention: Safety hazard

Before closing the parasol make sure that there are no people or objects near it. To fold the parasol canopy:

- 1. Remove the caps securing the holes on the back of the parasol leg.
- 2. Turn the crank towards the leg, at the same time depress the handle trigger and without letting go, pull the handle downwards.
- 3. Fasten the safety band.
- 4. Secure all openings located on the rear of the leg with caps.

In order to avoid staining of the cover, you should only close the parasol in dry weather conditions. We also recommend purchasing a protective cover. If the parasol has been closed while being wet, open it as soon as possible and let it dry. Any kind of position change may take place only after folding the parasol. It is advisable to seek the help of a second person.



▲ Attention: Safety hazard

FASTEN THE SAFETY BAND (Fig. 3). Failure to fasten the band may cause the umbrella to open automatically during a gust of wind, which poses a further risk of health loss, property damage, and even loss of life.

8. Maintenance and care

The customer should carry out a thorough inspection of the parasol using the list below, after the first installation or before storing the parasol. Do not use any sharp tools such as knives or metal scrapers or caustic cleaners to clean the parasol. Do not use garden hoses or high-pressure cleaners for cleaning.

Canopy / Textile:

- Do not chemically clean the canopy / fabric.
- Water wash by hand lightly squeeze.
- Surface wash lightly rub heavily soiled areas with a wet sponge. Washing temperature-maximum 40°C.
- Type of washing agent light washing agents for coloured products, e.g. grey soap.
- Draining and drying do not twist, dry upright hanging in the open air at 19 25 degrees Celsius.
- Do not use organic or chemical solvents and do not chlorinate.
- Keep away from open flames. In case of arson, extinguish with water, powder or snow extinguisher.

Frame construction elements:

- Clean with a damp cloth soaked in soapy water or washing-up liquid. To remove dust, dirt and other contaminants deposited on the structure.
- Before the start of the summer season it is recommended to maintain the leg tube on which the parasol opening mechanism moves. The leg tube should be cleaned with a cloth soaked in benzine (do not use on plastic parts) and then a thin layer of silicone oil should be applied to make the mechanism work easier. Maintenance should be carried out at a frequency depending on the conditions of use and weather conditions, absolutely before the start of the season, and whenever the parasol components (including the frame) are dirty.

Removing the sheathing:

Necessary tools: phillips screwdriver

STAGES:

- Loosen the screw and remove the finial from the top of the parasol.
- Remove the pockets or ties (depending on the type of cover) and unfasten the velcro of the main cover from the frame arms.
- Remove the pockets securing the cover to the frame on the long arms.
- Unscrew the straps securing the sheathing to the frame on the short arms.
- Remove the sheathing.

Putting the sheathing on is carried out in reverse order.

Annual maintenance:

The customer should carry out a thorough inspection of the parasol using the list below, after the first assembly or before storing the parasol for a long time.

9. Storage


The parasol and all its parts must be stored in a dry, frost-free room.

To avoid stains or dirt, before folding the parasol:

- Clean the base, frame and cover.
- Allow the covering to dry completely.
- If you have bought a protective cover you should put it on and store the parasol in this way. If you don't have a dedicated cover you should protect your parasol with another form of protection such as air permeable fabric.
- Keep out of reach of rodents.

⚠ Caution: before storing or transporting the parasol, pull the cover from between the arms of the frame Failing to do so may result in damage to the fabric.

- Fig. A. Open the arms of the parasol.
- Fig. B. Pull the canopy out in the direction of the arrows.
- Fig. C. Close the arms in the direction of the arrows.
- Fig. D. Wrap the canopy around the closed parasol.
- Fig. E. Fasten the safety band.




